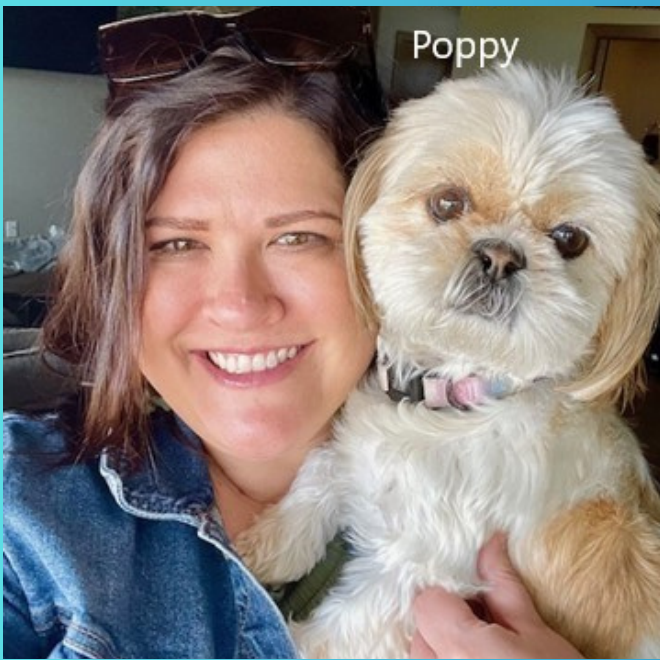
Interior work continues with finishes on the 4th floor nearly complete and will continue down 3rd to 1st, respectively. We will see the arrival of appliances and finishes through April and May. Work has started on the 1st floor, and we are now starting to see staff offices and therapeutic group rooms take shape!

Exterior coating has begun, and the crew is preparing to complete the final side of the exterior by the last week of April. This will make the building look uniform with Phase I and really allow us to envision ourselves in the completed space!

All timelines are currently on track to have occupancy turned over at the beginning of June and the parking lot expansion to commence in July. Be on the lookout for our open house and ribbon cutting invitation which is tentatively scheduled for August!
